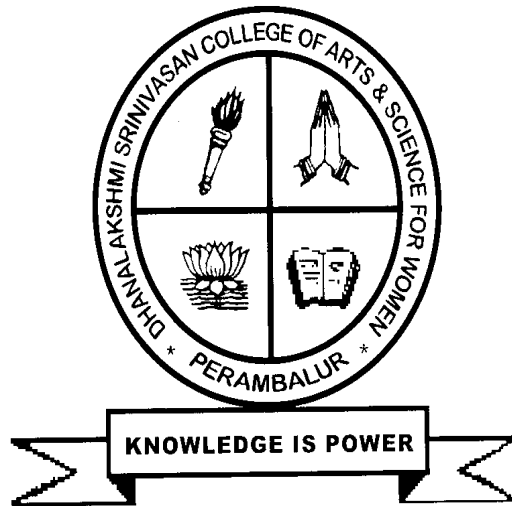

PGDBI, Functional English, Tally and IGNOU certificate programmes are offered in the college.

- Students are asked to write assignments in all the subjects.
- Students are asked to prepare for seminar apart from curriculum.

**23. Courses in which student’s assessment of teachers is introduced and the action taken on student’s feedback:**

For all subjects, there is a student assessment of teachers. Student assessment of teachers has been followed in all courses since their views are to be considered to enhance quality culture in the campus. The assessment reports are evaluated using specially programmed software. Those teachers who fail to impress students that are those who are getting less than 80% in the evaluation are counseled by the HoD and the Principal. In case where the Head itself has not got the required percentage, she is counseled by the Principal.

The written suggestions regarding improvements in library services are received from the students through the Suggestion Box and these considered for necessary action. Based on the feedback, teachers are intimated individually by the Principal in an amicable atmosphere - good performers are appreciated and other staff members are motivated to improve their performance.

Feedback from the Parents, Alumnae, record are collected. The results of the stakeholder survey are analyzed and communicated within the organization and to the stakeholder groups either as part of the Organization’s social accounts or in some

other way. If the stakeholder's analysis results in a need for development actions, these actions are planned with persons responsible and implementation schedules. The feedback obtained from the parents enables the institution to identify the needs and expectations of the students to help and train them for their progression.

All the faculty members use LCD and OHP in their teaching methodology. The student presentations, subject wise and field work presentations are done using LCD and OHP. The Faculty extensively use internet in their academic work and students are given specific assignments for the same. To deliver higher education effectively to students, appropriate incorporations in curriculum on technological advancements are done. Almost all the departments have introduced papers based on computer languages and packages. The computer lab, Bioinformatics lab and net park (students and staff) provide computer and internet access to staff and students. Regular programmes on MS. Office and MS Excel are conducted by the faculty members of Computer Science department to teaching and non teaching staff.
